## GENERAL GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

School believes in discipline and in firmness. Slackness, disobedience and disregard of rules will not be tolerated. Any work or action likely to lower the image of the school is regarded as a breach of the school discipline.

1. Parents are requested not to enter into class-rooms to see their children or the teachers during class hours without the permission of the Principal.
2. They are required to inform the school if there is any change in their address and telephone numbers.
3. Leave for half-day should not be asked for security reasons. In emergency, written permission must be taken from the Principal and the Class Teacher should be informed.
4. Children when sick should not be sent to school to attend test / classes.
5. **IMPORTANT** : PARENTS ATTENTION is drawn to the fact that criticism of the teacher or School in the presence of a child should be scrupulously avoided because it causes the students to lose respect for their teachers with the consequent failure to learn from them and will retard his/her progress.
6. Should there be any legitimate complaint, please see the Head Mistress / Director / Counselor at once or write in a separate letter addressed to him / her who will go into these matters personally.
7. A child returning to school after suffering from infectious diseases like chicken pox, measles, conjunctivitis, etc. he/she should not come to school until he/she recovers fully.
  - a). Chicken Pox : Till complete falling of scabs.
  - b). Cholera : Till the child is completely well.
  - c). Measles : Two weeks after the rash disappears.
  - d). Mumps : Until the swelling has gone.
  - e). Jaundice : Six weeks.
8. Any communication made by the Parents / Guardians, should be addressed to the Director, Head Mistress and to the Class Teacher.

9. The name, admission no., class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on belongings of the student as Sweaters, Blazers, ties, jerseys, pants, shirts, socks, shoes, handkerchief, Tiffin boxes and bottles.
10. Parents are required to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and by taking interest in their child's work. They should check the diary every day and note the home work and other instructions given, they are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any notice / invitation etc. has been issued.
11. Care must be taken of all school property and if any damage is done will be made good by the concerned student with a fine imposed for the offence.
12. Parents are strictly advised not to grant any pocket money to the students.
13. Parents are advised to see that their wards don't bring valuable articles and jewellery to school.
14. All students are expected to join the school on the notified date at the beginning of the term. Those absent without sanctioned leave will be fined at the rate Rs. 10/- per day. Absence for more than three days just before the vacation and immediately after the vacation renders the student to pay a fine of Rs. 30/- per day and after three days name of the students will be struck off the rolls. It is compulsory for the students to complete 90% of the attendance in the year to make them eligible to sit for final examination. Parents are asked not to apply for leave if can possible be avoided. Leave can be granted to the student only on the following grounds:
  - (1). In case of severe illness or death of a very near relative.
  - (2). To attend the marriage of his / her real brother / sister or uncle.(father's/mother's real brother or sister)
15. Parents are asked to get the child's blood group checked.

**16. Management has given privilege to organize Parents-Teacher Meeting bi- monthly on last Sunday for the convenience of parents. Previous Saturday of the Parents-Teacher Meeting will be holiday for the whole School.**

17. Visiting Hours of Parents :  
The School would always desire parents to maintain a close rapport with the teachers teaching their wards in the school. Parents are advised to meet the respective Class Teachers on the Second and the Third Saturdays after School Hours.
18. Canteen is only from 6<sup>th</sup> onwards. Kindly don't send any amount with primary students to buy tucks.

**IMPORTANT:** Parents are strictly advised to authorize any particular person who will come to take the child back home.

## **Code of Conduct for Student**

1. They should take good care of their health and keep themselves fit and strong.
2. They should always be friendly to others in and out of the School.
3. They should avoid vulgarity in talk and behaviour.
4. They should accept whatever work is assigned to them as their rightful share. They should face difficulties courageously.
5. They should always be ready to lend a helping hand at home to their parents, brothers and sisters, in School to teachers and companions and any unattended visitor, whom they happen to meet in the School premises.
6. They should never cheat or be unfair at play.
7. They should stand, when any teacher or visitor comes to talk to them.
8. They should be truthful, whatever the cost.
9. They should never be cruel.
10. They should respect the beauty of the Class room and of the School premises and report any damage they may observe.
11. They should respect the liberty and the right of other.
12. They should look upon people from all parts of the world as their brethren, irrespective of their caste, colour and creed.
13. They should not waste their time in idle gossip.
14. They should take pride in wearing their School Uniform.

## **School Rules :**

1. Every student should carry his/her School diary every day.
2. Students should arrive at School 5 minutes before the start.
3. The warning bell before a class or assembly is a signal for all to go to the assembly or to their respective classrooms. This should be done promptly and in silence. As soon as they are in their classes, Students must get their books ready for the period.
4. Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. The School uniform should be worn on all working days and for all School functions.

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6. No shouting or whistling is allowed in or around the School building. Running in corridors is strictly prohibited.
7. It is strictly forbidden to throw any object at any one.
8. Care must be taken of all School property and no student should scratch or spoil the desks or chairs or damage any School furniture or write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the Class Teacher or to the Principal.
9. Any damage done will be made good by the concerned students, together with a fine imposed

on him/her for such an offence. Any one who notices something damaged, should report the matter even if he or she does not know who has done it.

10. Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is not permitted.
11. The School is not responsible for articles lost. It is forbidden to bring articles like Cell Phones, expensive watch or fountain pen, transistor, C.D. Camera, Calculator, I-Pod, etc. to School.

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13. Students should observe polite manners wherever they go. They should always remember that the School is judged by their conduct. They should greet their teachers when they meet them. Bullying and use of foul language are punishable offences.

15. Exploding crackers, splashing colours etc. in the School premises are strictly forbidden. Non-compliance of these instructions can result in expulsion from the School.
16. Indiscipline, disobedient and notorious students would be given three warnings and thereafter they would be issued a T.C.
