



If you are working in a group or team, as a team leader you should use pronouns like 'us' and 'we' while speaking. In short, I can say words can have a lot of power if you know how and when to deliver them. Communication is a complex process that makes entire communication effective if you speak from your heart and mind.

कोई भी एक समाज कई प्रकार के लोगों का समूह होता है। एक समाज में सबकी अलग-अलग भूमिका होती है। कोई एक परिवार या व्यक्ति किसी एक भूमिका को अपनी पसंद क्षमता या गुण के अनुसार ग्रहण करता है। इसलिए सभी एक विषय को एक हीँ समय में ऍक जैसे नहीं समझ पाते। एक परिवार में भी सभी की क्षमता और पसंद अलग- अलग होती है। लेकिन सभी एक दूसरे के पूरक होते हैं और किसी उद्देश्य को प्राप्त करने में सफल होते हैं। एक सदस्य किसी काम को बेहतर कर पाते हैं तो दूसरे सदस्य किसी और काम को इस तरह कोई बड़ा काम बेहतर तालमेल से होते हुए दिखाई देता है। आप परिवार के किसी विवाह समारोह में अक्सर देख पाते हैं जिसमें कोई भोजन व्यवस्था करते नजर आते हैं, तो कोई मेहमानों की देखरेख, तो कोई बाजार का काम कर रहे होते हैं। ग्रामीण क्षेत्र में पढ़ने वाले बच्चों की बौद्धिक क्षमता में कोई अंतर नहीं होता लेकिन उन्हें अवसर कम मिलते हैं और व्यवस्था भी। हम अक्सर् देखते हैं कि स्कूल के किसी एक कक्षा में पढ़ने वाले बच्चों में भी कोई गणित में बेहतर है तो कोई भाषा में कोई खेलकूद में तो कोई गीत संगीत में उन्हें किसी एक पैमाने पर नापा नहीं जो सकता और ना ही उस आधार पर भेदभाव किया जा सकता है। अगर समाज में भेदभाव है तो उस भेदभाव् को दूर करने की शुरुआत परिवारों में बच्चों से चर्चा करते हुए और स्कूल में बच्चों के बीच समझाते हुए होनी चाहिए ।बच्चे स्कूल में इस बात का जरूर ध्यान दें कि कौन है जो खेल नहीं पा रहे हैं लेकिन खेलना चाहते हैं उनकी मदद कैसे करें उन्हें सिखाया कैसे जाए। कोई गणित बनाने में कठिनाई महसूस कर रहे हैं तो उन्हें कैसे आपस में सीखने के लिए समझाया जाएँ ।इसी तरह लड़के और लड़कियों के लिए सामान खेलकूद की व्यवस्था करने पर्ध्यान देना चाहिए कोई स्टेज पर अपनी बात् रखने में घबराते हैं तो अवसर देकर आगे लाया जाए और बच्चों को भी समझाया जाए इस तरह के छोटे- छोटे प्रयोग बच्चों को एक भेदभाव रहित समाज की स्थापना की ओर प्रोत्साहित करेंगे।

CYBERETHICS

Teaching children cyberethics is something we must do to protect them. Now a days everything is online. For educators and parents, using cyberethics principles could be a great way to ensure children know how to avoid the numerous threats around the digital space. We must help children the real risks and scope of cyber threats. An excellent way to approach cyberethics education is to address misconceptions children might have about the topic.



For example, one common myth children believe is that having an antivirus app installed on a computer protects one from all cyber threats. The reality is very different.

We need to teach kids empathy and how to avoid unacceptable online behaviours. Sometimes even a text message can be extremely hurtful and lead to unexpected consequences. That's why it's important to teach children that writing online messages, comments, replies, and other texts without thinking first is a major part of ethical behaviour. We need to teach children to respect other people's feelings.

In many cases, children don't let their parents, teachers, or peers know that they're getting bullied online. That's why we need to help children know how to protect themselves online. They can start by knowing their school's policies for reporting bullying. They should also know that they can report the bad behaviour to the platform or social media network where it occurs. Also, we can let them know that we will support them regardless of the situation, so they feel more comfortable sharing any details.

The right time to start educating children about cyber ethics is: as soon as possible.







Kavad Katha of Rajasthan



Recently I read a news about Pupul Bisht, a daughter of India who was invited to share her thoughts about the future of humanity on the platform of the 76th session of the United Nations General Assembly. She presented a vision for the future through folklore stories at the Sustainable Development Goals Moment. It was very interesting to learn that she follows a method of future analysis inspired by the Kaavad Katha of Rajasthan. Pupul told that the entire picture of the future is contained in the folk tales of India. I was so very curious to know about this art of storytelling and found some very interesting facts. Let's begin.. Kaavad is a 400 year old Rajasthani Oral tradition originated as a ritual, which involves a wooden box with painted doors and stories from mythology and folklore. The Kaavad is a mobile story-telling device that sometimes serves as a temporary temple. Kaavad is created by suthar, an artist is a chitrakar, and a story teller is a bhat. Kaavadiyas or storytellers would visit patron families and use the Kaavad to tell stories which drew from mythology (the Mahabharata, the Ramayana and Puranas), then turned to local folklore, and finally to the lineage of the family or clan itself. Through this storytelling, wisdom was also imparted.

ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES


