Augmentation of Campus Facilities (2025–2026)

The academic session 2025–2026 witnessed remarkable advancements in the school's infrastructure, reflecting the institution's commitment to providing a safe, inclusive, and technologically enriched learning environment for its students. Continuous efforts were made to refurbish the campus and upgrade facilities to support both academic excellence and holistic development. The key developments undertaken during the session include:

Smart Classrooms: All classrooms were equipped with smart boards and advanced digital teaching aids to facilitate interactive and technology-enabled learning.

Computer Laboratory: The computer lab was upgraded with modern computer systems and high-speed internet connectivity to strengthen digital literacy and support technology-based education.



Web-App Computer Room for Senior Students: A separate and well-equipped computer room especially for the WEB-Application faculty was constructed in the 2nd floor of senior wing building to facilitate the students with advanced computer learning, research, and project-based work.

Science Laboratories: Well-organized and fully equipped separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology were developed. These labs include modern apparatus, workstations with sinks, gas connections, and electrical outlets, along with essential safety provisions such as gloves and fire extinguishers.

Library Expansion: The school library was enriched with a wide collection of new books, reference materials, and digital resources to promote reading habits and intellectual curiosity among students. An add-on of about 2000 books were made this year to enhance the reading skills of the students.
